**Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,**

I hope this finds you well and in good health. In anticipation of the COVID-19 pandemic slowing more, we look forward to reopening. The major cornerstone in allowing us to reopen is universal baseline testing of residents and staff. New guidance, issued just this week, requires providers to test residents and staff for COVID -19 prior to July 30. All of our resident and current associates baseline testing was negative. Currently in Indiana County, there are 297 positives, and deaths remain at six.

Resident Impact (May 15, 2020 through July 30, 2020).

3	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
2	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19 <b>Recovered</b>
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
0	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
0	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Once a County has moved into the “Green Phase,” a minimum of 28 days must pass from entering this phase and assume the following conditions are met:

- No active or new Covid-19 cases within the last 28 days
- The facility is not experiencing staff shortages
- The facility has adequate supplies of personal protective equipment and essential cleaning and disinfection supplies to care for residents
- The facility has adequate access to testing for COVID-19
- Referral hospital(s) have bed capacity on wards and intensive care units

We continue to work with the Department of Health on follow-up measures. Our residents and staff members are monitored for signs and symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

Your concerns are important. We are preparing COVID-19 landing page on our website to address your concerns by offering resources, a set of frequently asked questions and

our reopening plans. We continue our fresh air visits for you to visit with your loved ones. They are going well and I have received much positive feedback! You can schedule after 9 AM with the front office at 724-465-3900. We are continuing Monday to Friday visits, with hopes to extend the hours in the near future. Our three-phase Reopening Plan is on our website for your review.

Please know that we extend our most sincere gratitude to you and yours as we continue to provide attention to those in our care as we all navigate these unprecedented times. As always, please contact the facility with any questions.
