Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

It is hard to believe that Saturday at 5:44 PM, **Summer** officially begins! This is also, the longest day of the year! I hope this finds you getting back to some of your regular activities as we are in Green Phase for a full week. We are all getting used to some "new normals" in our daily lives! As I venture out in our community, I see a mixture of those with masks and those without. We continue to work towards the goal of returning to our regular visiting for all of you. Our residents miss seeing you and so do we! It continues to be challenging, but everyone has done an awesome job to assure things are as "normal" as possible. We continue to wear masks, as do your loved ones. With the warmer weather we are venturing outside in our courtyards to enjoy the sunshine and beautiful blue skies while socially distancing.

As we discussed last week a major cornerstone to allowing us to reopen is universal, baseline testing of residents and staff. Several of our facility nurses have been trained to perform the tests. Today, the Department Leaders reached out to you by phone to inform you of the testing of your loved one at the beginning of next week as well as the testing of ALL STAFFS. This process will occur over two days. The tests will be collected and sent to a Department of Health Laboratory for processing. They will inform us of the results within 72 hours.

At the current time, new admissions are being tested prior to transfer into the facility and placed in a private room for 14 days. We continue to assess all residents with vital signs and lung assessments each shift. All staff received education regarding our upcoming testing in

meetings this week, as well. We are completing ongoing staff education and audits related to infection control.

A large part of our strategic preparation is staffing contingency plans and breaking the facility into different zones for positive, presumed positive or exposed, and negative results. Follow up testing procedures will be based on the initial testing outcome. Information will be placed on our website www.indianhaven.com.

We continue to report our data to a number of sources on a daily and weekly basis. This data is now publicly published by the Pennsylvania Department of Health on a routine basis.

I appreciate your patience and support during these challenging times. Continue to send cards, letters and care packages. Stop by for a window visit or contact us for a phone/facetime visit. Thank you for allowing us the privilege or caring for your loved ones and we are working to reunite our Communities at Indian Haven Family!
