## Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

I hope this finds you well and in good health. On behalf of the staff, we thank you for entrusting us with caring for your loved ones. We strive daily to provide the very best in care. We continue to monitor COVID-19 cases within our county and emphasize basic control procedures. The safety of our residents and staff is our priority. We are working with the Department of Health on follow-up measures. Our residents and staff members are monitored for signs and symptoms consistent with COVID-19 daily. Currently in Indiana County there are 382 cases with 9 deaths reported.

Once a county has moved into the "Green Phase," a minimum of 28 days must pass from entering this phase and assume the following conditions are met:

- No active or new Covid-19 cases within the last 28 days
- The facility is not experiencing staff shortages
- The facility has adequate supplies of personal protective equipment and essential cleaning and disinfection supplies to care for residents
  - The facility has adequate access to testing for COVID-19
- Referral hospital(s) have bed capacity on wards and intensive care units This week we began breakfast and lunch in the main dining room on the Green Zones. We have two settings for each meal. The tables were placed six feet apart with two residents per table. Today, Residents had their first Patio Picnic! Everyone was excited! Next week we will be holding a FUN Fair in the courtyard with games, food and fun! Check out the Facebook page and website!

We will be resuming the Fresh Air Visits and benevolent visits on Tuesday August 25<sup>th.</sup> We will attempt to accommodate week-end visits with prior approval for those who are unable to visit Monday to Friday. We continue to follow the visiting guidelines of pre-screening for ALL VISITORS, masking and hand sanitizing. Scheduling will be from 9:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. at 724-465-3900. Things can change as issues arise with our Re-opening Plan regarding visiting for the safety of your love ones.

We are attempting to hire a Beautician to provide hair care services as we know this is a huge concern for all! Sadly, Brenda Gray has resigned after 40 years of service to the Residents of Indiana County! She will be sorely missed by all. We wish her good health and happiness in retirement!
