## Dear Friends, Families, Residents and Caregivers,

We are monitoring our county positivity rates in the hopes that we can invite you back into the facility to visit your loved one. Many counties have made progress and that is encouraging. Currently in Indiana County the positivity rate is 8%. We have been able to decrease our testing to once weekly as a result of the decreased positivity rates, which gives a ray of **HOPE**! The total county cases are 4.939 with 154 deaths.

Current visitation protocols will remain in place for now. We are following guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Department of Health (DOH) and Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). There are no new protocols related to visiting. We do continue to offer Compassionate Care Visits for end of life.

Meanwhile, we encourage our residents, staff and families of our community to become vaccinated against COVID-19. And remember, even after vaccination, please continue to maintain physical distancing, use caution when attending gatherings, wear a mask and practice hand hygiene. These are principles of cleanliness set forth by the CDC.

We are participating with the Vaccine Partnership Program. Our pharmacy partner, CVS, is providing onsite vaccination clinics for our staff and residents. The vaccine includes a series of two injections, scheduled 21 to 28 days apart. Our final in-house clinic will be Monday, February 15. There is still and opportunity to get Residents and Staff their first vaccine. We are partnering with Indiana Regional Medical Center to schedule second vaccines. They utilize the Pfizer vaccine, as well.

The percentage of Residents who received the vaccine is 97%. The percentage of Staff who received the vaccine is 72%. We have noted minor side effects such as headache, sore arm and tiredness. We continue to monitor all Residents every shift including temperature and respiratory assessment.
