Dear Friends, Families, Residents and Caregivers,

As we continue to monitor and follow the latest <u>Centers for Disease Control (CDC)</u> COVID-19 infection control guidance, we are taking into account how it impacts our residents and visitors.

Residents who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19 should only receive visits that are virtual, through windows, or in-person for compassionate care situations, with adherence to transmission-based precautions and core infection control principles. Here are the latest care guidelines for retirement community and independent living residents from the CDC.

Unfortunately, we had a setback last week due to a staff member testing positive. We are now testing all staff and Residents weekly for the next two weeks. If all tests are negative, then we can change to GREEN and resume visitation in the facility. We continue to quarantine **ALL new admissions for 14 days and permit window visits, phone calls or zoom/virtual visit. Eligible compassionate caregivers may visit using appropriate precautions.** Long-term care residents may do outdoor visits if both parities are vaccinated but must socially distance. Indoor visits are conducted using the screen between the resident and their visitor. Please contact us to assure we have a place for your visit. Meals are served in the resident room and no group activities are permitted.
