## Dear Friends, Families, Residents and Caregivers,

I am happy to report that our vaccination rate for Residents is 85% and Staff 80%. Indiana County has 37.7 % of our community fully vaccinated. I would encourage you to get vaccinated. The Covid impacted our most vulnerable population, the elderly. Throughout our organization there have been minimal side effects from the three types of vaccines administered in our county (Pfizer, Moderna Johnson and Johnson).

Regarding safety, the CDC recommends guidelines for safe mask activities.

We continue to monitor and follow the latest <u>CDC COVID-19 infection control guidance</u> with relation to its impact on our residents and visitors. Here are the latest care guidelines for <u>retirement community and independent living residents from the CDC.</u>

Visiting remains Green. We encourage you to take your loved outdoors on these beautiful, sunny days. Our courtyard has a shaded porch and gazebo with plenty of places to sit. Please assure sunscreen is used if you are setting in the sun. YOU must still screen in at the rear entrance prior to visiting and pass the screening. If your loved one is vaccinated and you are vaccinating, you may visit together without masks and social distancing as long as they do not have a roommate. Visiting areas are available in the main dining room, hallway by the dinging room and front/side entrance. All new admissions who are vaccinated have a butterfly on the door.

We are implementing drop offs (clothes, snacks, etc.) in the front of the building via the main door entrance from Monday to Friday 8 AM to 5 PM. Please ring the bell when you arrive. We are also asking that you work around our peak meal time which are: Breakfast 8 AM to 9 AM, Lunch 12 Noon to 1 PM and Supper 5 PM to 6 PM. Staff is busy at this time assuring all residents receive meals promptly and transporting from the dining rooms.
