Dear Friends, Families Residents, and Caregivers,

We continue to monitor and follow the latest <u>Centers for Disease Control (CDC)</u> infection control guidance with relation to its impact on our residents and visitors. Residents who are o transmission-bases precautions for COVID-19 should only receive visits that are virtual through windows, or in person for compassionate care situations with adherence to transmission-based precautions and core infection control principles.

Here are the latest care guidelines for retirement community and independent living residents from the CDC.

We are continuing our visiting policy for fully vaccinated residents and fully vaccinated family members. If a resident is in a private room, you may visit if both parties are vaccinated. Otherwise we have wonderful outdoor spaces in the courtyard, around the front of the building and in dining areas. It is so good to see all of you! Everyone is a lot happier! We wish to remind you again about our peak meal times: breakfast 8-9 am, Lunch 12-1pm, and supper 5-6 pm. Our staff is busy assisting with meals during these times to assure residents are served promptly. Drop offs can be made Monday to Friday at the front entrance. Please place the last name on any items you wish us to deliver. Those who are unvaccinated must wear a mask and socially distance during visits.

Our staff vaccinate rate is currently 81% for staff and 96% for residents. Diamond pharmacy was here to administer vaccines on June 17. Indiana county vaccine rate 40%, county positivity rate is 1.1%. PLEASE get vaccinated!
