We have endured very stressful and challenging times in caring for our most vulnerable population in the midst of a pandemic. To maintain that fight, we continue to encourage all to help in the fight against a new strain of COVID-19 by becoming vaccinated, which makes one less susceptible to the emerging variant.

Our Facility's Resident Impact (May 15, 2020, through July 15, 2021):

18	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
64	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
27	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Screening with the Accushield remains in effect upon entrance and exit to the facility at the rear entrance. This is our ONLY entrance at this time. Don't forget to hand sanitize! Visiting remains the same for fully vaccinated residents and fully vaccinated family members. If your loved one has a private room or no roommate, you may visit. We can make arrangements for a place to visit and assure your ones is prepared for the visit. We encourage you to enjoy our outdoor spaces. We are doing our best to assure that visits continue. It is wonderful to see everyone again! **PLEASE continue to wear a regular mask when visiting. Long term care regulations still require it.** I know this is confusing for you! Residents who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19 should only receive visits that are virtual, through windows, or in-person for compassionate care situations, with adherence to transmission-based precautions and core infection control principles. I want to alert you that on **July 21<sup>st</sup>**, **our power will be out from 8:00 AM to 4 PM**. This is due moving of the lines. We have a plan to assure we maintain routines as much as possible. We will have portable generators running, phone system operational and special meals planned.
