All previous screening, hand hygiene, mask wearing and social distancing remain in effect.

## Our current vaccine rate for residents is 94% for fully vaccinated; 97% of our staff have both vaccines; and, on November 22, 2021, 100% of staff will be fully vaccinated.

We are following guidance from <u>(CDC)</u>, <u>Department of Health (DOH)</u> and <u>CMS</u> as well as the latest <u>COVID-19 infection control guidance</u> with relation to its impact on our residents and visitors. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation with our masking and social distancing protocols for our facility. Our utmost priority is to protect the residents and staff and their families.

19	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
79	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
30	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.
