Our current vaccine rate for residents is 97% for fully vaccinated. 98% of our staff have had both vaccines; On November 22, 2021, 100% of staff will be fully vaccinated.

0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
80	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
30	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.
